# GRAMMAR SCHOOL GENERAL GUIDELINES

## **Apparel:**

- Clothing must be clean and free of holes, tears, or excessive fraying.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times except during active recess.
- Only school sweaters are allowed for additional warmth indoors.
- Girls must wear light grey leggings or bike shorts under dresses or skirts.
- Dresses and skirts must be at or below the knee throughout the school year.
- Please mark your children's belongings with a permanent laundry marker for easy identification.
- Garments should be sized appropriately for your child's frame; oversized clothing is not allowed.
- Student apparel and school gear (e.g., backpacks, lunch containers, notebooks, etc.) shall not display any political messaging, commercial slogans, product promotions, celebrity representations, sports team promotions, or any pictures/cartoons of commercial characters.

## **Hair and Accessories:**

- Hair should be kept neat, clean, well-groomed, and styled conservatively in natural colors.
- Hair accessories should be in school colors (khaki, gray, navy, red, or white), moderate in size, and non-distracting.
- No hats, caps, hoods, headscarves, or bandanas may be worn inside the school building.

## **Outerwear:**

- Only approved uniform items may be worn as the first layer over a uniform shirt. Refer to grade-level lists for specific items.
- Non-uniform sweaters or sweatshirts are not permitted.

## **Jewelry:**

- Girls are not allowed to wear bracelets, rings, exposed necklaces, or non-prescription eyeglasses. Earrings should be studs or posts, not hoops or dangling earrings.



- Boys are not allowed to wear earrings, bracelets, exposed necklaces, or non-prescription eyeglasses.

**Shoes:**

- Sturdy shoes or tennis shoes with laces or velcro are permitted (no embellishments like pictures, wheels, lights, or high heels).
- Shoes with laces must be worn with appropriate, tied laces.
- Boots, Ugg-style shoes, open-toe shoes, sandals, or flip-flops are not allowed.

**Guidelines for Dress Down Days:**

- **Tops:** Shirts, blouses, and tops must have sleeves and cover the shoulders. Low-cut, sheer, or revealing tops are not permitted.
- **Bottoms:** Pants, jeans, skirts, and shorts must be in good condition without holes, tears, or excessive fraying. Shorts and skirts should be of modest length, reaching at least mid-thigh. Leggings are permitted only under dresses or skirts.
- **Footwear:** Closed-toe shoes must be worn. Sneakers are acceptable. No sandals, flip-flops, or open-toe shoes are allowed.
- **Accessories:** No hats, caps, hoods, headscarves, or bandanas may be worn inside the school building.
- Student apparel and school gear should not display political slogans, commercial promotions, celebrity images, sports team logos, or commercial characters.
